SUBJECT: Recommendation of Award: RFP05-003-SV, "Albuquerque Police Department Comprehensive Information System"

The City of Albuquerque Department of Finance and Administrative Services, Purchasing Division, issued the subject Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Albuquerque Police Department.

The RFP was posted on the Purchasing Web Site and advertised in the local newspapers. Forty-two Requests for Proposals were sent to interested vendors. Twelve vendors attended the mandatory pre-proposal conference. Four responses were submitted for evaluation.

The ad hoc evaluation committee reviewed, evaluated and scored the responses, in accordance with the evaluation criteria published in the RFP. The committee invited two short-listed companies to demonstrate the proposed system and unanimously recommends award of contract to Tiburon, Inc. contingent upon appropriation of funds for this procurement.

Geographical preference and community involvement program points were not applied for this RFP in order to qualify for federal grant funds.

Listed in ranking order are the respondent's composite score, average score and total amount proposed, which includes one-year warranty and future annual maintenance:

Funding for the project comes from a variety of sources, including: Capital Improvement Program Bond Funds; a Justice Assistance Grant; False Alarm Revenues; Seizure Program Revenues; and the ¼ Cent Public Safety Tax.


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I concur with the ad hoc committee's recommendation. The Department will begin contract negotiations immediately appropriations of funds for this project.
